## **64 PowerPack Commands Summary Chart**

Key Command	Description	
PowerWord		
НОМЕ	Move cursor to the top of the screen.	
CLR/HOME	Move cursor to page 1, line 1 of the document.	
INST	Insert one character at cursor's location.	
DEL	Delete one character at cursor's location.	
RUN/STOP	Reset the word processor.	
SHIFT- RUN/STOP	Exit to BASIC.	
CTRL-H	Display the Help screen.	
COMM-R	Reformat text on the screen to the specified margin and line length.	
<b>←</b> 10,60	Sets the margins and line length of your document. In this example, the document will have margin of 10 spaces and each line will be 60 characters in length.	
SHIFT- RETURN	Adds or removes a "hard return".	
CTRL-P	Begin spellcheck (a.k.a. Proof-read).	
F1	Insert a new line. The cursor must be in column 1 of the document.	
F2	Delete a line (from column 1) or delete from cursor's position to the end of the line.	
F3	Save, Load, Catalog or Print.	
F4	Change screen colours.	
F5	Move to next Tab, or to the end of the line.	
F6	Set or clear a Tab on the Tab Ruler.	
F7	Move forward to top of next page.	
F8	Move backward to top of previous page.

F1	Insert Row or Column.	
F2	Delete Row or Column.	
F3	Load, Save, Catalog or Print.	

Key Command	Description
	PowerWord
F4	Set Screen Colours.
F5	Copy/Paste Cell Contents. When copying formulas, you are given the option to make the cell references <i>Fixed</i> or <i>Relative</i> .
F6	Clear Cell Contents.
F7	Recalculate spreadsheet formulas.
F8	Set Column Width.
SHIFT- RUN/STOP	Exit to BASIC.
=SUM(a1:a5)	Will sum the values in cells a1 thru a5.
=AVG(a1:a5)	Will calculate the average of the values in cells a1 thru a5.
